This was a historical flood because a comparable one had not been seen for more than one hundred years.

I went there three days after the flooding occurred and I was able to observe personally the magnitude of the damage, the confusion of the stricken population and the ruined landscape that followed. Material damage was tremendous. According to official statements, there were around fifty dead people in Ghardaïa only, but an actual number of hundred dead and missing people is certainly closer to reality.

Fortunately, there have been no dead or wounded among the people I know; however, two of them had their houses severely damaged.
