During the past decade there has been a considerable increase in the number of natural disasters which have caused hardships in many countries. Disasters are not confined to particular regions nor do they discriminate between developing and developed countries. For the past year alone, widespread floods in France, Hungary, Italy, Switzerland, Algeria and Vietnam as well as devastating earthquakes in Salvador and India have reminded us of the need to take global preventive measures against disasters.

During the 1990s, there was ten per cent annual increase in economic loss due to disasters. Global warming is expected to increase the incidence of disasters such as storms, droughts and floods. Although we continue to refer to these disasters as natural, they are, to a large extent, man made. Population growth, together with population movements and displacements, the uncontrolled growth of mega cities, the increasing emissions of carbon dioxide, deforestation and desertification are all human factors which play a key role in the increase of natural disasters.

Perhaps the most significant lesson we have learnt from the recurrence of disasters is that "no man is an island". Solidarity, close coordination and long term commitment in such community issues are necessary to promote a culture of disaster prevention through collecting food aids, donating either money or blood, providing assistance, helping with medical care, and cleaning affected areas after disasters.
