TEXT:

Luca Romano, from Spain, talks about how people's manners and habits have changed over the years.

He says:

"When I was a young boy, my grandfather used to live with us. He was a polite and very respectful man. He always told **me** to say please and thank you, and to respect older people. At that time, my parents worked all day, so my grandfather took care of me. He was patient and always smiled when I made mistakes." (§1)

"Nowadays, I notice that many young people forget to use polite words. **They** talk loudly in public and sometimes ignore elderly people. In my opinion, good manners are slowly disappearing." (§2)

"When I was a child, I used to greet everyone politely. I remember saying Good morning to my teachers and neighbours. But today, many teenagers are on their phones all the time and don't even look up when someone greets them." (§3)

"In my mother tongue, **we** also have two ways of addressing people: one formal and one informal. We use the formal one with teachers or strangers, and the informal one with friends or family. However, young people now use the informal way with everyone, even with teachers." (§4)

"Maybe **this** is because of the influence of English and social media, but I still think we should keep our traditional ways of showing respect." (§5)

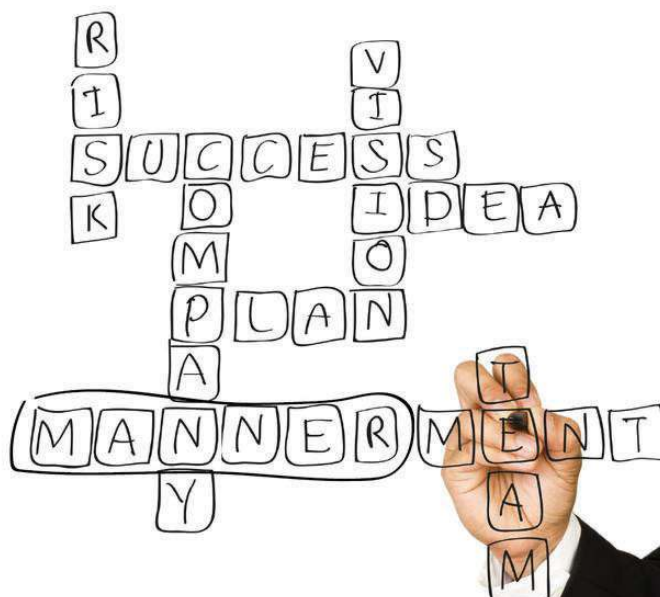
